A group exhibition, titled 'Gridded Currents', curated by guest curator Hyunjin Kim, will be on view at the Kukje Gallery, Seoul, from July 20 through August 20, 2017.

The participating artists include Nina Canell, Ayoung Kim, Runo Lagomarsino and Charles Lim. The Gallery has also been promoting Korean artists to non-commercial venues, using its solid network of museum curators and critics worldwide. Many of Korean artists who have been presented by Kukje Gallery have gone on to participate in international biennials and major art museum exhibitions.

Ayoung Kim (b1970) lives and works in Paris, France and Seoul, South Korea. After completing a degree from M.A. in Fine Art, Chelsea College of Arts, London, UK the artist took part in exhibits like "In This Vessel We Shall Be Kept", Palais de Tokyo, Paris, France in 2016 and "Zepheth, Whale Oil, Hanging Gardens, Shell (Lecture performance accompanied by a publication)", at The Book Society, Seoul, South Korea.

Charles Lim Yi Yong (b1973, Singapore) completed his B.A. in Fine Art, Central Saint Martin's School of Art and Design, London, UK and lives and works in Singapore. The artist's latest exhibit includes "Stealing the Trapeze" at Johann Jacobs Museum, Zurich, Switzerland.

Runo Lagomarsino (b 1977 in Lund, Sweden) lives and works in Malmö, Sweden and São Paulo, Brazil. The works and collections can be seen at Cisneros Fontanals Art Foundation, Miami, USA, Collection Paulo A. W. Vieira, Rio de Janeiro and São Paulo, Brazil and Coppel Collection, Mexico City, Mexico to name a few.

Nina Canell (B 1979 in Växjö, Sweden) lives and works in Berlin, Germany. Recent exhibition lists include "Dolph in Dandelion", Le Crédac, Ivry-sur-Seine, France Ayrton and "Foam-Skin Insulated Jelly-Filled Vowel", Galerie Barbara Wien, Berlin, Germany".

The exhibition will be on view at Kukje Gallery, 54 Samcheong-ro, Sogyek-dong, Jongno-gu, Seoul, South Korea.
